


### **AEPEA 2018 PUBLICATION RULES**

The text may be published in the journal of the Society (SEYPNA) “Cuadernos de Psiquiatría y Psicoterapia del Niño y del Adolescente”, providing it meets the following requirements:

Rules for publication of oral presentations for the **8th European Congress on Child and Adolescent Psychopathology**, to take place at the Palacio Euskalduna in Bilbao from 26th to 28th April 2018.

1. Originals must be sent by email in DIN A-4 size with line spacing of 1.5; 12-point Times New Roman font without numbering. The maximum length is 25 pages including text, bibliography, tables, drawings, figures and graphs.
2. The **first page** must consist of:
  - a) Full name of author/s (3 will appear in the main title, and more can be added at the foot of the page); professional and organisation (place of work), correspondence address (postal and email); telephone or fax number.
  - b) **TITLE** and **ABSTRACT** of the article in English, though other languages can be added to these. The abstract must not exceed 150 words. **KEY WORDS**: between 3 and 5 words that adequately identify the content of the paper in both languages.
3. **Footnotes**: these are to be numbered in the text in consecutive Arabic numbers.
4. **Tables, drawings, figures and graphs**: these must also be presented in Word format below the paper, numbered in order of appearance in the text. Each of them must have a title or caption in English.
5. **Bibliography**: texts must abide by the rules in the APA (American Psychological Association) publication manual, among which the following are recalled:

- Bibliographical references must be listed in alphabetical order. Where there



is more than one source cited by the same author, they must be listed in chronological order, starting with the oldest.

- Bibliographical references **in the text** are to be made using the author's surname and the year of publication. e.g. (Bion, 1962), and to cite different works by the same author/s with the same date, the letters a, b, c, etc. should be added to the year, which will always be the same. e.g. (Freud, 1900a, 1900b).

- Bibliographical references to **books**: author (surname, comma and initials of first names followed by full stops – if there are various authors they should be separated with a comma plus "and" before the last author); year (in brackets) and full stop; full title (in italics) and full stop; town followed by a colon, and publisher. To indicate books are in translation, the reference "Orig." and the year (in brackets) should be added at the end. Example: Lebovici, S. and Soulé, M. (1973). *El conocimiento del niño a través del psicoanalysis*.


Mexico: Fondo de Cultura Económica (Orig.1970).

- Bibliographical references to **chapters in books where the chapters are by different authors**: author/s; year; title of the piece cited followed by "In" and then the initials of the first names and then the surname of the editors, directors or compilers, followed by ed., dir., or comp. in brackets, adding an "s" if they are plural

(eds.); the title of the book in italics and, in brackets, the pages of the chapter cited; the town and the publisher. Example:

Boulanger, J.J. (1981). Aspecto metapsicológico. In J. Bergeret (ed.), *Manual de psicología patológica* (pp. 43-81). Barcelona: Toray-Masson (Org. 1975).

- Bibliographical references to **journals**: author, year (in brackets); title of article; full name of journal (in italics); vol.; no. between brackets without being separated from the vol. where pages are numbered, and first and last page. Example:
